CRITERIA:

- A. LISHA member in good standing

- C. Current transcript
- D. Current vitae
- E. Two letters of recommendation/support (one from Department Chairperson required)
- F. Provide an outline of planned doctoral level research

Candidates may reapply in subsequent years, if they have not previously won the award. All Award winners must wait a period of two years before reapplying again.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: July 1, 2010
