

Presenter

Susan Hendler Lederer, Ph.D. is an Associate Professor in the Department of Communication Sciences & Disorders at Adelphi University, Garden City, Long Island, NY. She has 29 years experience in the areas of speech, language, and emergent literacy development and disorders.

Since 1998, Dr. Lederer and her Adelphi colleagues and students have been conducting and researching programs for toddlers with language delays. Efficacy and descriptions of these programs have been published in peer reviewed journals and presented nationally. This research led directly to publication of her first two children's books, *I Can Say That* and *I Can Do That*, designed to facilitate early language acquisition and emergent literacy skills. *I Can Play That* is scheduled for release Summer 2010.

Overview

This workshop will focus on the emergent language period. Focus will be on the first lexicons of typically developing children and those with delays, parent-report tools, a descriptive-developmental approach to choosing targets and the evidence to support using focused stimulation and milieu teaching to facilitate first words.

Coming from East: SOUTHERN STATE PKWY/SOUTHERN PKWY W. Merge onto WANTAGH PKWY N/WANTAGH STATE PKWY via exit number 27N toward WESTBURY. Take the exit W2 W toward OLD COUNTRY RD. Turn SHARP LEFT to stay on VALENTINES RD. VALENTINES RD becomes THE PLAIN RD. End at 718 THE PLAIN RD WESTBURY NY. Proceed to large parking area at center.
